STATION GUIDE

- 1. TREAT WHEEL.** As you come into our Winter Festival, the first stop is our Treat Wheel. You will get one spin to see which kind of goody is in store for you. You will also be handed a bag to keep up with all your other prizes.
- 2. SNOW BOWLING.** Once you come into the Red Room, your fun really begins. A special helper will give you a snowball and you will have two tries to knock down as many penguin pins as you can. Can you get a strike?
- 3. RUDOLPH & THE PEPPERMINT FOREST.** Take a picture with everyone's favorite holiday reindeer as he relaxes in the Peppermint Forest.
- 4. FEED THE SNOWMAN.** Step on up and see if you have what it takes to keep the abominable snowman at bay. You will have three chances to feed him all the snowballs he can eat.
- 5. REINDEER RINGTOSS.** Bob loves helping out during Winter Festival and what better way to do that, then be our reindeer. You will get three tries to get as many rings around Bob's newly grown antlers as you can. Good Luck!
- 6. PENGUIN RACETRACK.** Do you have what it takes to waddle like a penguin? We're going to give you the chance to try. You and an opponent will step up and place a ball between your knees. The person to make it to the other side without dropping their ball first wins.
- 7. PIE IN THE FACE.** We brought back everyone's favorite station with some new faces added to the list. You will step up and take a roll of the die to see how many chances you'll get to make the ball hit the target. You better stretch your throwing arm now!
- 8. BREAK THE ICE.** This station is for anyone that has ever wanted to break a board. Whether this is your first time ever or you've done it several times before. You will get three chances to punch your way through one of our re-breakable boards.
- 9. BLUE ROOM ICE CAVES.** A blizzard started whirring outside and the only shelter around are the Blue Room Ice Caves. All the lights are off, and a mysterious creature can be heard taking a nap nearby. There's nothing to fear though because a trusty elf guide is there to lead each of our guests through the caves with a flashlight. Just be careful not to make too much noise or you could wake up the sleeping creature.
- 10. HOT COCOA.** Let us warm you up after the caves by giving you a cup of hot chocolate before you go. You will have the option to add marshmallows or just sip it plain, but either way be careful not to burn your tongue.
