STATION BUIDE

- 1. SCAVENGER HUNT & TREAT WHEEL. As you come into our Winter Festival this year, we want everyone to stop by our treat wheel and take a spin to see what kind of special treat is in store for you. Afterward, you will be handed a Scavenger Hunt that you can complete as you make your way through the whole festival!
- 2. SNOW BOWLING. Once you come into the Red Room, your fun really begins. The first stop on our Winter Festival is snow bowling. You will get two tries to knock down all our penguin pins and earn a treat to add to your bag.
- **3. PICTURE WITH RUDOLPH.** Strike a pose with everyone's favorite holiday reindeer. Mrs. Courtney will be there to take your picture so don't worry about bringing a camera, just your smile!
- **4. FEED THE SNOWMAN.** Step on up to see if you have what it takes to keep the abomidable snowman at bay by tossing a snowball into his mouth. Don't fret if you miss on the first try though because you will have two more chances to get it just right.
- 5. **REINDEER RINGTOSS.** Bob wanted to lend a helping hand to this year's festivities, so he volunteered to be our reindeer for this fun challenge. You will have three chances to get a ring around one of Bob's newly grown horns. Good Luck!
- **6. PEPPERMINT FOREST.** Take a walk through our special striped forest on your way to our outdoor section of Winter Festival. Try not to go too fast though or it might get crowded.
- 7. PENGUIN RACE TRACK. Do you think you have what it takes to waddle like a penguin? At this new activity, you're going to get the chance to try. You will roll the die to see how many chances you get and then you have to try and make the ball hit the target. So, stretch out your throwing arm and get ready to show us what you can do!
